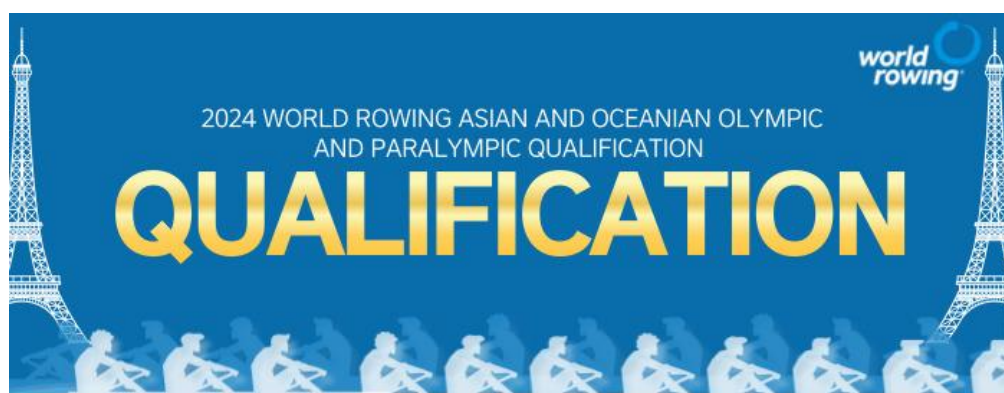

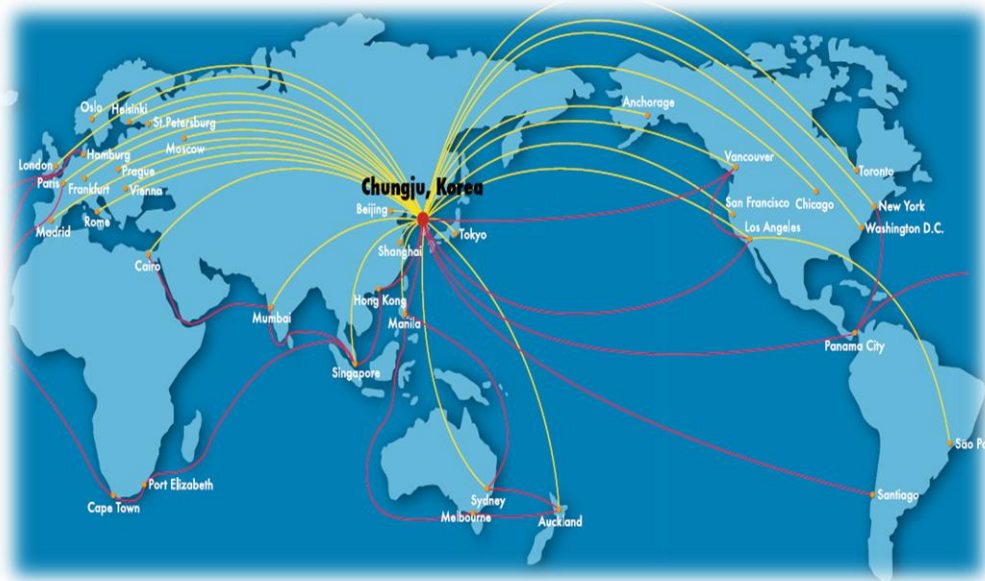
Fairness

Seeding

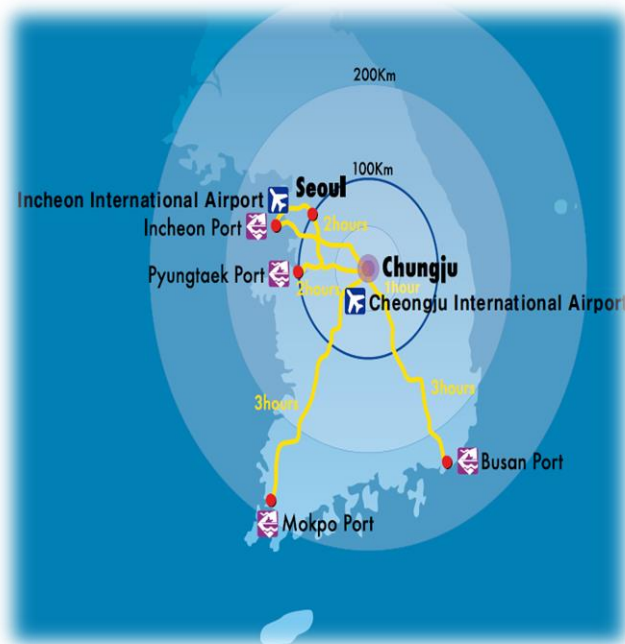
Depending on the number of entries, some events may be seeded. Seeding will follow WR seeding policy and will be conducted by the WR Seeding Panel.

General Introduction of Korea, Chungju



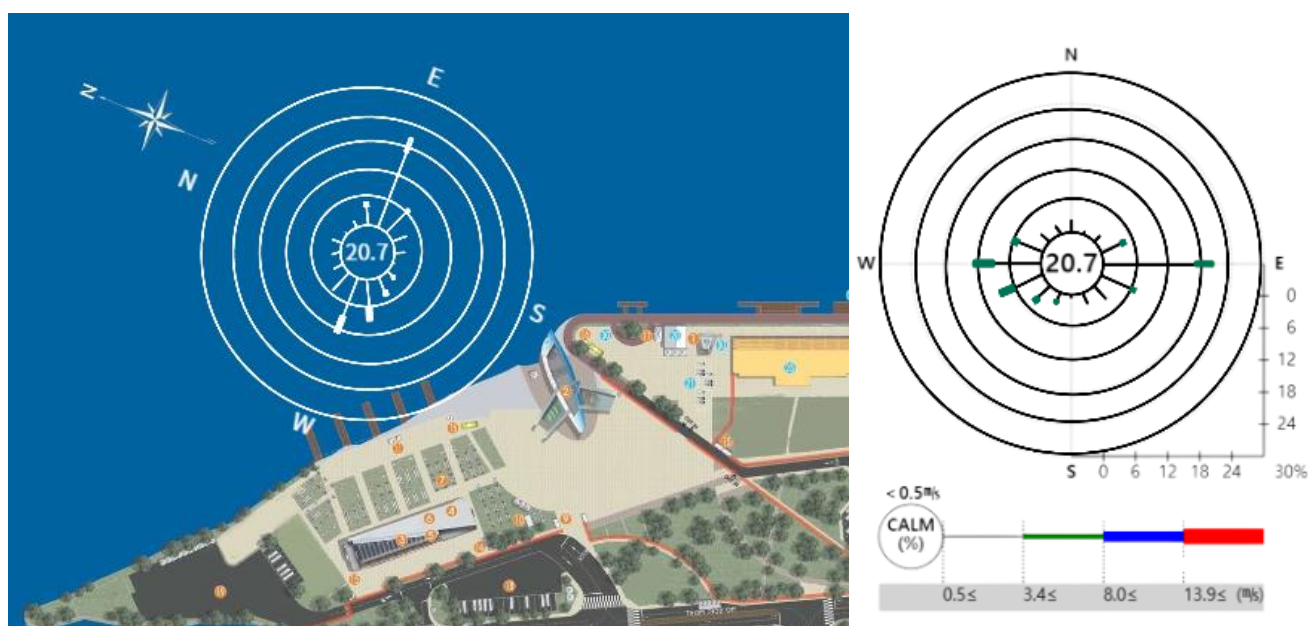
Representing a green city in Korea, surrounded by a clean lake, river and mountains. A city with rich cultural heritage and diverse tourist resources, Chungju, the dream city that will open a bright future for dynamic water sports. Located at the centre of Korea and North East Asia.

Chungju is centre of the Korean Peninsula, which is in proximity to China and Japan and lies in the heart of North East Asia. The city is equipped with great transportation infrastructure, ensuring easy and convenient access not only to mega cities like Seoul and Busan, but also to each and every region of the country. A green city with the most suitable weather conditions for rowing, with an average annual temperature of 11.5°C, four vivid seasons of a continental climate, 1,065.3mm average annual precipitation and no natural disasters, such as typhoon, flood and heavy snow. Chungju is a suitable arena for water sports, such as rowing.

 Tangeum Lake International Rowing Regatta is a lake naturally-formed by Chungju Dam and boasts great scenery attributable to its location in-between low hill with dense woods and water bodies.

1. Shipping Documents

- 1) Original ATA Carnet - 1 set / if any shipping under ATA carnet
- 2) Invoice & packing list should be as precise as possible with regards to item, quantity, unit price, total price, weight and volume - 1 set

2. Import Customs Regulations

- 1) TEMPORARY IMPORT (Returnable Goods)

It's strongly recommended to ship under ATA Carnet for any shipment to be returning to Origin, After competition.

- 2) PERMANENT IMPORT: Free for distribution-GIVEAWAYS & PROMOTIONAL MATERIALS
- Free distribution valued at less than USD5.00 per unit price (C.I.F) are allowed
 - Provided that total value and quantity of the goods are reasonable in the opinion of the Customs Authorities.
 - However, it is not allowed to import “CIGARETTES, ALCOHOLICS, FOOD & BEVERAGE, MILITARY, FIREARMS, MEDICAL EQUIPMENT etc” into Korea.

**Permanent & Consumed Goods are not packaged together with return Goods under ATA Carnet, even shipping document(Please Do not mix ATA Carnet / Permanent & Consumed Goods)3) SOLD EXHIBITS: SOLD exhibits (contracted for SALE in Korea during the show) must be checked with customs office and then closure of the show for permanent import procedures

Member Federations who intend to ship their boats must contact the shipping agent immediately to ensure boats delivery on time. The O.C. is not responsible for contacting the shipping agent or for any delays in the shipment arrival.

3. Insurance

It is strongly recommended and the shippers responsibility that all equipment is insured against any possible loss of or damage for the whole “Round-trip”

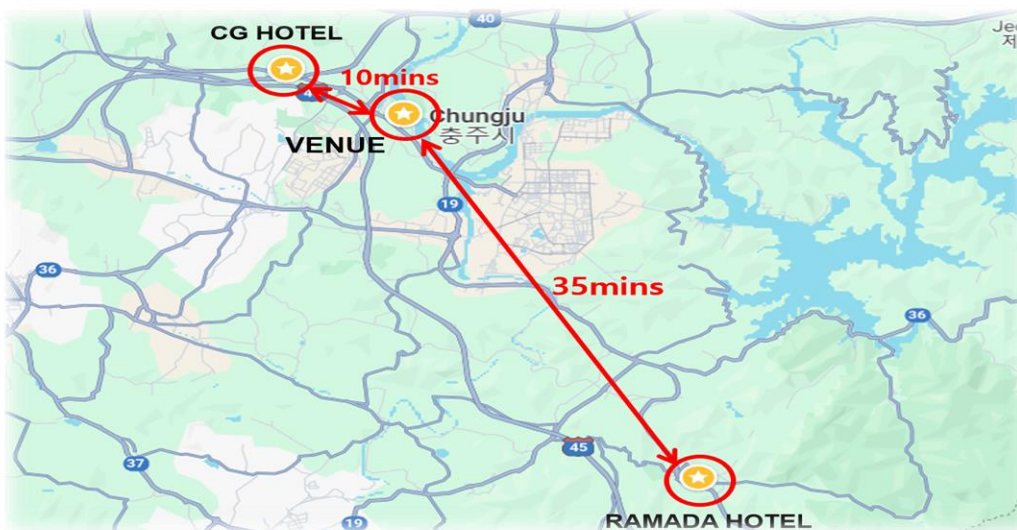

Health and Safety

Liability

The participants/teams are responsible for all insurance costs of equipment and persons. The OC declines all liabilities for all kinds of damage and injuries/sickness during teams' stay.

To make sure that all regatta arrangements are clear, please keep in regular contact with the LOC & ask for assistance if required.

World Rowing Commitment Form

It is a priority for World Rowing to preserve the health and safety of the athletes and coaches. Please read the World Rowing Statutes, Rules of Racing and kindly acknowledge Appendix S10, Byelaw to article 57 of the rules (World Rowing Commitment Form). Safety matters and safeguarding policy are referred to explicitly to help ensure awareness amongst participants, in terms of their responsibilities and their well-being. Rowers may only compete in the WR Asia-Oceania Olympic and Paralympic Qualification Regatta (WR AOPQR) if they have submitted a signed commitment form. Event: Asia Oceania Olympic and Paralympic Qualification Regatta

Type of Classification Offered: Physical, Visual

Dates of Classification: 17 – 18 April 2024

Classification Documentation Deadline: **3 March 2024**

Please note that the Classification Documentation Deadline is 45 days prior to the classification panel. This is the deadline by which all classification documentation for the athletes must be uploaded to the [RowingTwo](#) portal. The instructions to do this are attached. Please upload your documentation and email the request to classification@worldrowing.com.

Kindly be remind that, athletes with a valid sport class status cannot be reclassified unless their review date has passed, or unless you have requested a medical review in accordance with the World Rowing Rules.
